In the affidavit dt.17.2.2016 filed by Ms Medha Anant Gadgil presently working as Additional Chief Secretary, Medical Education and Drugs Department, Mantralaya, Mumbai, it is stated that a comprehensive present status report was called about upgradation of mortuaries in various Government hospitals in the State of Maharashtra. It is further stated that the work of upgradation of mortuaries in various Government hospitals would require expenditure of Rs.61,71,78,064/- only for manpower, equipments and infrastructure etc. However, the affidavit is totally silent on the aspect as to within how much period the State Government proposes to undertake the work of upgradation of mortuaries. Merely calling a report without taking any steps for implementing the recommendations in the report would serve no purpose.

We, therefore, direct the State Government

to place on affidavit as to what the State Government proposes to do with the report; whether the report is to be kept in the cold storage or whether the State Government proposes to take positive steps for implementing the recommendations in the report. The affidavit shall also state that if the State Government proposes to accept the recommendations in the report, within what time schedule it proposes to implement the same.
