This application has been filed to implead the defendants 9 to 11 in C.S.No.535 of 2019.

- 2.Learned counsel for the applicant would submit that the proposed 9th, 10th and 11th respondents, who are the alleged mortgagees/purchasers of the property mortgaged by the second respondent.
- 3.The said application has been vehemently opposed to by the learned Senior Counsel appearing for the defendants 1 to 3 by relying upon the Sale Deed under which the Members of Applicant's Association claims title. He would submit that the property that had been purchased by the eleventh defendant do not form part of the property that had been sold to the Members of Applicant's Association but however, the same is refuted by the learned counsel appearing for the plaintiff and also submit that there in an ingress through which seriously affect the rights of the Members of the Applicant's Association.
- 4. Since the learned counsel appearing for the plaintiff would seriously dispute that is used only one ingress & egress to the property and most of the

6.Learned Advocate Commissioner shall not wait for the warrant to be issued by this Court, he shall proceed to inspect the aforesaid property either by today or tomorrow and submit a report to this Court on 30.06.2023.

7.Learned Advocate Commissioner shall be entitled to initial remuneration of Rs.30,000/-.
