<u>Prayer:</u> Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the third respondent to remove the

garbage bins found in front of the petitioner's residence in Jarugu Village, Maniyathahalli Panchayat, Nallampillai (TK), Dharmapuri District – 636 807 and to direct the third respondent not to remove soil or indulge in any sort of act which would obstruct the petitioner's access to the petitioner's residence as aforesaid.

## ORDER

The writ petition is filed seeking a direction to the third respondent to remove the garbage bins found in front of the petitioner's residence in Jarugu Village, Maniyathahalli Panchayat, Nallampillai (TK), Dharmapuri District – 636 807 and to direct the third respondent not to remove soil or indulge in any sort of act which would obstruct the petitioner's access to the petitioner's residence.

2.It is the case of the petitioner that he is the owner of the land in S.No.1164/27, having purchased the same under registered Sale Deed dated 09.09.2022. The petitioner constructed a residential house and two commercial shops in the said property. It is the specific case of the petitioner that the fourth respondent, who is elected as President of the third respondent Panchayat obstructed his right of access to his house, by putting three garbage bins right in front of his house.

3.In this regard, the petitioner sent a representation to the first and second respondents and the same has not been considered. Therefore, the petitioner has come before this Court by way of this writ petition.

4. When the matter is taken up for hearing, Mr.L. Naveen Kumar for Mr. Arasakumar, learned Government Advocate appearing for the second and third respondents, on instructions submits that the garbage bins installed in front of the petitioner's house have been already removed and there is no impediments for the petitioner to access his house from the road. He also produced the photographs in support of his claim. The said statement made by the learned counsel for the second and third respondents is recorded.


