In view of the intervening developments, leading to the order dated 19.7.2012 passed by the Director, Women and Child Development, Himachal Pradesh, which is taken on record, whereby, 13 employees of the ICDS Project have been taken over by the Government, including Smt. Rama Kumari of the Ankur Welfare Society Gagret, it cannot be said that there is any contumacious conduct on the part of the respondents and the COPCs are dismissed. Rule is discharged. We make it clear that this order shall not stand in the way either of the petitioners or any other person covered by the order, pursuing their grievances, if any still surviving, in appropriate proceedings.

2. So far Smt. Neelam Kumari, petitioner in COPC No. 297 is concerned, it is pointed out that her husband is missing for the

last around seven years and now she is posted at Bilaspur and her family is at Una. Therefore, there will be a direction to the Director to look into the matter within a week from the date of production of a copy of this judgment and see whether Smt. Neelam Kumari can be adjusted in Una.
