Reply on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3 is on record, perusal whereof reveals that dearness allowance has already been paid to the petitioner alongwith pay during his entire service period, which fact stands duly established with the placing on record salary statements of the petitioner for the period 10/2007 to 6/2017 (Annexure R-1) and remaining part of the judgment is yet to be complied with by respondent No.4.

On the vehement request of learned Deputy Solicitor General of India, further four weeks' time, as prayed for, is granted to respondent No.4 to do the needful, failing which, respondent No.4 shall remain present in Court on the next date of hearing to explain that why property of the department as well as salary of the erring officials, be not attached towards the implementation/ execution of the judgment sought to be executed.
