The petitioner has been made an accused for the offence registered under Section 363 and 366 (A) of the Indian Penal Code.

Heard Learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in this case though the allegation is that this petitioner had eloped with the informant's sister, but in fact the victim girl has stated in her statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C that she on her own sweet will had gone with the petitioner as they were having love affairs for the past two years.

Learned counsel for the state has opposed and submitted that the victim girl is minor and aged about 17 years.

Regard being had to the facts and circumstances of the case, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st, Seraikella in connection with Rajnagar P.S. Case No.6 of 2014 corresponding to G. R. No.161 of 2014.
