The petitioners are apprehending their arrests in connection with Sahibganj (M) P.S. Case No. 25 of 2014 corresponding to G.R. No. 90 of 2014, for the alleged offences under Sections 376, 504 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

There is direct allegation against the other co-accused to have committed rape upon the complainant informant. So far as these petitioners are concerned, it is only alleged that they abused the complainant and her father in the panchayati.

In the facts of the case, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners, Md. Safique Ali and Md. Badrul Haque. Accordingly, it is directed that in the event of their surrender / arrest, the petitioners, named above, shall be released on bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each, with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sahibganj, in connection with Sahibganj (M) P.S. Case No. 25 of 2014 corresponding to G.R. No. 90 of 2014, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
