The applicant, who is in custody since 15.10.2022, has approached this Court for grant of regular bail.

The applicant is an accused of committing murder.

It has been submitted by the counsel for the applicant(s) that complete set of FIR along with its enclosure have been annexed with this bail application and there is no suppression on his/her part.

Innocence has been claimed and participation in the trial has been assured. It has been submitted that investigation is already complete and during investigation, only material collected is confession of this applicant and save and except confession, there is no other material against him. On the above facts, prayer for bail has been made.

On the other hand, learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the fact that investigation is already complete and it is a case of circumstantial evidence, I am inclined to enlarge the applicant (s) on bail. Accordingly, the applicant(s), above named, is/are directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned J.M.1st Class, Palamau at Daltonganj, in connection with Patan P.S. Case No.82 of 2022 on the condition that the applicant(s) will submit self-attested photocopy of his/her/their Aadhaar Card and also submit his/her/their mobile number before the learned court below which he/she/they will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
