1. Heard learned senior counsel for the applicant and learned counsel for the State.

- 2. The applicant, who is in custody since 11.10.2022, has approached this Court for grant of regular bail in connection with Dumka Mufassil (University O.P) P.S. Case No.204 of 2022, corresponding to G.R. No.67 of 2023, registered for the offence under Sections 395/412 of the Indian Penal Code.
- **3.** It appears that F.I.R has been lodged against 14-19 unknown miscreants. Subsequently two Trucks loaded with iron pipes have been intercepted and some co-accused have been apprehended. This applicant has been roped in the present case on the basis of confessional statement of the apprehended co-accused.
- **4.** It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the applicant that complete set of F.I.R along with its enclosures have been annexed with the present bail application and there is no suppression on his part.

Innocence of the applicant has been claimed and undertaking has been given for participation in the trial. It has been submitted that this applicant has no criminal antecedent. He is a labourer and works in West Bengal. On the above basis, prayer for bail has been made.

- **5.** On the other hand learned counsel for the State have opposed the prayer.
- 6. Considering the period of custody, I am inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail. Accordingly, the applicant is directed to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Dumka, in connection with Dumka Mufassil (University O.P) P.S. Case No.204 of 2022, corresponding to G.R. No.67 of 2023, on the condition that the applicant will submit self-attested photocopy of his Aadhaar Card and also submit his mobile number before the learned court below which he will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
