05/30.08.2024 Heard Mr. Nishad Khan, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Arup Kr. Dey, learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner has prayed for grant of anticipatory bail, as he is apprehending his arrest in connection with Chhattarpur P.S. Case No. 220/2022.

An Indica car was intercepted and on search 250 liters of wine was recovered from the seat.

So far as the petitioner is concerned, he seems to have been implicated on account of the fact that he is said to be the owner of the Indica car having purchased the same from Govind Singh for an amount of Rs.51,000/-.

Learned A.P.P. has failed to submit anything from the Case Diary which would indicate that the ownership of the Indica car was transferred in the name of the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid facts, I am inclined to extend the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks and on his surrender, he shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned JM 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Palamau in connection with Chhattarpur P.S. Case No. 220/2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

This application stands allowed.
