The anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of petitioner, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Dhanbad P.S. Case No. 108 of 2022 for the offence registered under Sections 379, 384 read with Section 34 and 120B of the Indian Penal Code pending in the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Dhanbad, is pressed into motion.

As per the prosecution case, the petitioners on several occasions, in force and duress took total amount of Rs.1,50,000/- from the daughter of the informant.

It is submitted by the learned counsel on behalf of the petitioners that they are priest of Hari Mandir and there is land dispute regarding which title suit i.e. Original Civil Suit No.316 of 2018 has been filed and there is also dispute regarding priesthood of Hari Mandir, Hirapur, Dhanbad and the father of the informant was also priest in the said temple. It is further submitted that there is no definite date of incidence.

Learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the submissions made, the anticipatory bail application is allowed. Accordingly, the petitioners, above named, are directed to surrender before the learned Trial Court within a period of two weeks and in the event of their arrest or surrender, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court below, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

The petitioners will co-operate in the investigation and will appear under Section 41A Cr.P.C. as and when required and comply with the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
