07/16.12.2015 Heard Mr. Rakesh Kumar Sinha, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners, Mr. Abinesh Kumar, learned A.P.P. for the State and Mr. R.C.P. Sah, learned counsel appearing for O.P. No.2.

Petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Nimdih P.S. Case No.22 of 2015, registered for the offence registered u/s 498-A of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that petitioners are parents-in-law of the informant and no specific allegation has been levelled against them.

Mr. R.C.P. Sah, learned counsel appearing for the informant opposed the prayer for bail and submitted that these petitioners were also involved in demand of dowry.

Regard being had to the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioners above named are directed to surrender in the court below within three weeks and pray for bail, and in that event, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of Sri A. Kaccap, learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Seraikella in connection with Nimdih P.S. Case No.22 of 2015 corresponding to G.R. No.601 of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
