3/23.09.2015 Heard Mr. A. K. Kashyap, learned senior counsel appearing for
the petitioner and Mr. Awnish Shankar, learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner is an accused in connection with Jasidih P.S.
Case No. 124 of 2014 registered for the offences punishable under
Sections 419 & 420 of the I.P.C.

The allegation in the FIR is that by impersonating Kashish
Kumari, allowance under the 'Swami Vivekanand Nishakt Swablambar
Protsahan Yojna' was being withdrawn by another person.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner
that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case and it
has been submitted that one of witnesses Pramila Devi who has stated
against the petitioner was herself an accused in a case instituted by
the uncle of the petitioner. It has further been submitted that the
petitioner is in custody since 28.07.2015.

Learned counsel for the State opposed the prayer for bail and
referred to paragraph nos. 21, 22 & 23 of the case diary in which some
of the witnesses have stated about the role of the petitioner in setting
up his niece Nikita Kumari in place of Kashish Kumari. It has further
been submitted that the petitioner is a tout in the Circle Office and he
was directly involved with respect to such impersonation.

Regard being had to the nature of allegations, I am not inclined
to grant bail to the petitioner, which is accordingly rejected.
