- 1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that against the impugned demand as contained in memo no. 511 dated 22.05.2015 (Annexure-16 of this writ petition), the petitioner has already invoked alternative dispute redressal mechanism as provided under clause 14 of Fuel Supply Agreement vide representation dated 4th September 2015 (Annexure-18), but no decision has been taken, therefore, the petitioner was compelled to file this writ petition.
