- 1. Counsel appearing for the petitioner argues in detail that Opposite parties have not complied with the order dated 6th January,2012 passed by this court in WP(S) Case No. 5390 of 2010.

Counsel appearing for the State submits that a detailed counter-affidavit has been filed by Opposite Party No.2 to 5 and the order has been passed on 4.4.2012 which is at Annexure-B to the counter-affidavit.
