**Order No. 07/Dated 16<sup>th</sup> April, 2024**

**L.P.A. No.300 of 2023**

1. Mr. Manish Kumar, learned Sr. S.C.-II appearing for the State appellant, has submitted that in course of the day the defect which pertains to deposit of authentication fee of Rs. 10/- will be removed.

2. Let the said defect be removed in course of the day.

**I.A. No. 4941 of 2023 in L.P.A. No.300 of 2023**

3. With the consent of the parties the issue of limitation has been heard.

4. Since on the similar ground 119 days delay has already been condoned by the order passed by the Co-ordinate Bench while passing the order on 03.10.2023 in I.A. No. 7187 of 2023 filed in L.P.A. No. 282 of 2023, hence, there is no opposition on the part of the contesting private respondents in condoning the delay.

5. Accordingly, the delay of 119 days in filing the appeal is hereby condoned.

6. I.A. No. 4941 of 2023 stands allowed.

**I.A. No. 3624 of 2024 in L.P.A. No. 301 of 2023**

7. This interlocutory application has been preferred under Section 5 of the Limitation Act for condoning the delay of 283 days in preferring this Letters Patent Appeal.

8. Heard learned counsel for the appellant.

9. Having regard to the averments made in the application and submissions made on behalf of the appellant, we are of the view that the State appellant was prevented from sufficient cause

in filing the appeal within the period of limitation. As such, the delay of 283 days in preferring the appeal is hereby condoned.

10. I.A. No. 3624 of 2024 stands allowed.
