**Oral Order**

The anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of petitioner, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with C.P. Case No. 3007 of 2019 for the offence registered under Sections 323, 341, 420, 34 of the Indian Penal Code pending in the Court of Sri Subhash Bara, learned Judicial Magistrate, 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Dhanbad, is pressed into motion.

As per the prosecution case, the petitioner is land owner and in the year 1985, he had sold the land to the complainant measuring an area six Kathas. The main allegation is that on 30.06.1999, he sold the land to another person and when the complainant protested, he was assaulted.

It is submitted by the learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner that he had not sold his entire land under Plot No.1380 to the complainant and only part had been sold and the remaining part had been sold by him to other persons, therefore, offence under Section 420 will not be made out.

Learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the submissions made, the anticipatory bail application is allowed. Accordingly, the petitioner, above named, is directed to surrender before the learned Trial Court within a period of two weeks and in the event of his arrest or surrender, he shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court below, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
