04 / 16.08.2024 Petitioner was granted anticipatory bail by order dated 14.06.2024 passed in A.B.A. No. 8565 of 2023 with a direction to surrender before the learned court below within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of the order and the learned court below was directed to release her on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000/-.

2. The present application has been filed for extension of time to surrender before the court below as the petitioner being a poor lady could not arrange two sureties of the like amount for furnishing bail bonds and therefore, she could not surrender before the court below within the stipulated period.

3. In view of the submission made above, further two weeks' time is allowed to the petitioner to surrender before the learned court below and the learned court below on her surrender, shall release her on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees twenty-five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Special POCSO Judge-cum-A.D.J-V at Singhbhum, Jamshedpur in connection with Mango P.S. case No. 13 of 2018 corresponding to Special POCSO Case No. 174 of 2018 (s), subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

4. This criminal miscellaneous petition is disposed of.
