02/26.10.2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P. for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to remove the defects, as pointed out by the office during course of the day.

This bail application has been filed on behalf of the petitioner— Mahendra Soni with a prayer to release him on bail in connection with Ramgarh P.S. Case No. 157 of 2021, District- Ramgarh registered under Sections 457 and 380 of the Indian Penal Code, pending before the court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ramgarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and has not committed the alleged offence. He further submits that the victim has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner but no test identification parade was conducted to identify the petitioner. The F.I.R. was lodged against the unknown person. Learned counsel for the petitioner also submitted that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State has vehemently opposed the contentions made by the learned counsel for the applicant and contended that F.I.R. of the case reflects that the F.I.R. was lodged against the unknown person and identity of the petitioner was not fixed by the informant.

In view of the submission made and material available on record and also keeping in view the nature of the offence, it is a fit case for bail.

Accordingly, the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/-(Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ramgarh, in connection with Ramgarh P.S. Case No. 157 of 2021.
