Apprehending their arrest, petitioners- Pervez Alam and Shiv Shankar Gorai have moved this Court for grant of privilege of anticipatory bail in connection with Chandil P.S. Case No. 141 of 2022 registered under Sections 414, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, Rules 4, 54 of JMMC Rules, 2004, Rules 3, 9 of JMPIMTS Rules, 2017 and Sections 4(1-A), 21 of MMDR Act.

Heard the parties.

As per the prosecution case, the allegation against the petitioners is that during inspection by the informant, 60 cft of sand loaded on the vehicle without valid paper has been seized.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are the owner and driver of the alleged vehicle and they have no concern with the alleged sand.

The Addl. P.P. opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the submissions of learned counsel and the fact as discussed above, the anticipatory bail application is allowed. Hence, in the event of their arrest or surrender within a period of two weeks from the date of this order, the petitioners named above shall be released on bail on depositing Rs.10,000/- each as cash security and furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below, subject to the conditions laid down under section 438 (2) Cr. P.C.

The petitioners will cooperate in the investigation and will appear on notice under Section 41A of Cr. P.C.
