Counsel for the respondents submits that the petitioner is aggrieved by the order passed under Section 17 (1) of the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Securities Interest Act, 2002 (SARFAESI Act) and there is efficacious alternative remedy of appeal against this order, therefore this writ petition is not maintainable.
