This bail application has been filed on behalf of the applicant— Bokul Sk with prayer to release on bail in connection with Littipara P.S. Case No. 50 of 2021 registered under Section 379 of the Indian Penal Code pending in the court of learned J.M. 1st Class, Pakur.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that the F.I.R. of this case was lodged by the informant in regard to theft of 24 pieces of battery of HDL Company worth Rs.85,000/- by the unknown thieves. It is further submitted that the applicant is not named in the F.I.R. and his name surfaced during investigation. It is also submitted that neither any incriminating article was recovered from his possession nor T.I.P. was conducted to identify his complicity in commission of the alleged offence. The applicant has been languishing in jail since 06.09.2021.

Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State vehemently opposed the contentions made by the learned counsel for the applicant.

In view of the submissions made and materials on record, the bail application of the applicant is hereby allowed. Let the applicant be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.15,000/-(Rupees Fifteen Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the court of learned J.M. 1st Class, Pakur in aforesaid case.
