**I.A. No.12375 of 2024:**

1. The present interlocutory application has been filed on behalf of the applicant- Samarendra Kumar seeking intervention in this case.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the land in question from which the petitioner has been sought to be dispossessed is an ancestral one in which the applicant is co-sharer and he is in possession of the half portion of the said land. Thus, the applicant supports the prayer made in the writ petition. Accordingly, he may be permitted to intervene in the writ petition.
3. It is a settled law that role of intervener is to assist the Court in reaching a logical conclusion in the matter, however, the intervener cannot be given status of the petitioner. If any person has the same interest as that of the petitioner, he may also file similar writ petition seeking such relief.
4. Under the aforesaid circumstance, the present interlocutory application filed by the applicant, seeking intervention in the writ petition is misconceived and the same is, accordingly, dismissed.

5. The applicant may, however, take other recourse as available under law for redressal of his grievance.
