Heard the parties.

The applicants, who are in custody since 22.08.2022, have approached this Court for grant of regular bail.

The applicants are accused of committing offence under Sections 363/365/367 & 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It has been submitted by the counsel for the applicants that complete set of FIR along with its enclosure have been annexed with this bail application and there is no suppression on his part.

Innocence of the applicants has been claimed and undertaking has been given for participation in the trial. It has been submitted that the named co-accused Kiran Kumari had faced trial and she has been acquitted. For the self same offence, these applicants have been roped in. On the above basis, prayer for bail has been made.

Learned counsel for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the above facts, I am inclined to enlarge the applicants on bail. Accordingly, the applicants, named above, are directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Lohardaga in connection with Lohardaga (M) P.S. Case No. 18 of 2012 corresponding to G.R. No. 243 of 2012, subject to condition that the applicants will report once in a month to the concerned police station and also on the condition that the applicants will submit self-attested photocopy of their Aadhaar Card and also submit their mobile number before the learned court below which they will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
