**ORDER**  
**03.11.2023**

1. This Court vide order dated 17.07.2023 disposed of the writ petition filed by the petitioner in terms of the following order:

“08. In view of the aforesaid, this petition is disposed of at this stage itself with a direction to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner with respect to the fact that the printed license has not been issued despite the license already being granted in favour of the petitioner till 30.09.2025 and shall pass speaking order to that extent within a period of two weeks from the date a copy of this order along with copy of writ petition with annexures are served upon the respondents.”

2. Compliance report stands filed by the respondents, whereby the claim of the petitioner has been rejected by way of a speaking order dated 14.10.2023.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the order dated 14.10.2023 is not in consonance with law.
4. This Court cannot determine the validity of order dated 14.10.2023, as the writ court while disposing of the writ petition filed by the petitioner had

simply directed the respondents concerned to pass a speaking order. The said order has been passed.

5. In view of the above, **contempt proceedings are closed and the contempt petition is accordingly disposed of.** However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail appropriate remedy as available under law.
