This Writ Petition is filed under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India praying to direct the respondents to grant 27 service increments arrears and promotion for the post of diesel instructor to the petitioner, etc.,.

This Petition coming on for Preliminary Hearing this day, the Court made the following:

ORDER

Petitioner has sought for a direction to the respondents – Corporation directing for payment of 27 years' increment and promotion.

- 2. It is alleged that, he was working as a driver, now he is retired and during the course of his employment, increments were not given.
- 3. In this writ petition, except producing an order of suspension pending enquiry, nothing has been produced by the petitioner. It is not possible to know whether the increments alleged by the petitioner are given or not, whether he is continued in service or not. However, petitioner is given liberty to make an appropriate representation to the Corporation, along with necessary documents for his claim. If such a representation is made, Corporation may consider the same in accordance with law.
