This CCC is filed under Section 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Court Act praying to initiate contempt proceeding against the respondent No.3 for deliberate disobedience of the order passed by this Hon'ble Court in WP No.47121 of 2004 dated 4-12-2007 produced at Annexure-A and punish the respondent No.3 in accordance with law.

This CCC coming on for orders this day, **N. KUMAR J.**, made the following:

ORDER

Writ Petition Nos.47121/04 and 46697/04 were partly allowed by this Court by order dated 4th December, 2007, remanding the entire matter back to the Joint Commissioner (Administration and Human Resources), Mahanagara Palike, Bangalore, with a direction to reconsider the matter afresh and to take appropriate decision in accordance with law, after affording opportunity to the petitioners and in the light of the law laid down by the Apex Court and this Court in similar matters and dispose of the same as expeditiously as possible, at any rate, within three months from the date of receipt of the copy of the order.

- 2. Complaining disobedience of the said order, this petition is filed.
- 3. Today, learned Counsel for the respondents produced before us, the order dated 15.07.2009 considering the claim of the complainants herein in terms of the order passed by this Court. Therefore, though there is some delay,

the order is complied with. However, if the complainants are aggrieved by the said order, they are at liberty to workout their remedy in the manner known to law. **CCC** is dropped.
