Writ Petition is filed under Art.226/227 of the Constitution praying to quash the order dated 3.1.2012 – annexure A by the Land Tribunal, Bangalore East Taluk.

The Petition coming on for hearing this day, Court made the following:

ORDER

Compromise application is filed under O 3 R 3, CPC.

It is stated, the Land Tribunal has granted occupancy rights in favour of 4th and 5th respondents on 3.1.2012 in LRF INA CR 197/97-98 to the extent of 12 guntas in Sy.No.140 of Kalkere Village, K R Puram Hobli, Bangalore East Taluk. It is also stated, the 4th and 5th respondents are registered as occupants as per the revenue records, RTC as well as in the mutation register. At the instance of well wishers of petitioners and the concerned respondents, they have agreed to amicably resolve the issues. It is also stated, the 4th and 4th respondents have agreed and have no objection

for registering the name of the petitioner to the extent of 12 guntas in Sy.No.140 of Kalkere Village of K R Puram Hobli and have also undertaken not to disturb the possession of the petitioner.

Parties are present before the court along with their respective counsel and have also signed the compromise petition.

Petition is disposed of in terms of the compromise petition, in modification of the order of the Land Tribunal and the order of grant of 12 guntas in Sy.No.140 in favour of 4th and 5th respondents, is set aside.
