**ORDER**

1. The prayer in this Writ Petition is to direct 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent to consider the representations dated 27.11.2023, whereby the petitioners are claiming that the compensation be released to them.

In my view, since the petitioners are claiming that they are entitled to receive the compensation in respect of the lands that have been acquired, it would be appropriate to direct 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent to consider the request of the petitioners and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
