This writ petition is filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, praying to direct the second respondent to implement the order dated 31-12-1985 in Appeals No.422 and 429/1985 passed by the KAT vide Annexure-A.

This writ petition coming on for preliminary hearing in B-Group, this day the Court made the following:-

ORDER

Sri Muralidhar, learned Government Advocate takes notice on behalf of respondents.

Heard.

2. The grievance of the petitioner is that though an order is passed by the Karnataka Appellate Tribunal, Bangalore, as far back as on 31.12.1985 in Appeal Nos.422/1985 and connected matter, the same is not implemented as on this day. He brings to the notice of the Court that he has made number of representations for implementing the order of the Karnataka Appellate Tribunal. But the said representations are not considered as on this day. Hence, this writ petition is filed.

3. According to the petitioner the order at Annexure-A, dated 31.12.1985, passed by the Karnataka Appellate Tribunal has ended in finality. If the said order has ended in finality, the same has to be implemented by the concerned authorities. The petitioner has made number of representations praying for implementing the order of the Tribunal. In spite of the same, the



authorities have not implemented the said order. The order of the Tribunals/Courts shall be implemented at an early date. Accordingly, the following order is made:-

Respondent No.2 is directed to consider and dispose of the representations filed by the petitioner for implementation of the order dated 31.12.1985, passed by the Karnataka Appellate Tribunal, at an early date.

Writ petition is ***disposed of*** accordingly.
