2. And it is further ordered and decreed that the Respondent No.1 shall deposit the said sum of Rs.70,000.00 within eight weeks from today, failing which the said sum shall carry interest at 6% p.a. from this date till realisation.

3. And it is further ordered and decreed that out of the additional sum of Rs.70,000.00, a sum of Rs.40,000.00, shall be paid to minor (2nd appellant), a sum of Rs.20,000.00 shall be paid to 4th appellant (mother) and a sum of Rs.10,000.00 shall be paid to 3rd appellant (father).

4. And it is further ordered and decreed that the entire amount falling to the share of minor appellant shall be kept in fixed deposit until she attain majority. Guardian (Appellant No.4) is at liberty to draw interest thereon.

5. And it is further ordered and decreed that out of the amount falling to the share of 4th appellant, a sum of Rs.15,000.00 shall be kept in fixed deposit in
