THIS WRIT PETITION COMING ON FOR PRELIMINARY  
HEARING THIS DAY, THE COURT MADE THE FOLLOWING:

**ORDER**

Female child aged 4½ years in the custody of its mother when directed by the Additional Judge, IV Addl. Family Court, Bangalore, in G & W.C.No.240/2011 to be handed over to the custody of the father for a period from 1.5.2013 to 16.5.2013 by order dated 27.4.2013, is called in question in this petition.

2. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, perused the pleadings and examined the order impugned. The Family Court having had an occasion to have interaction with the child and the father found that the child was comfortable in the company of the father, following which, visiting rights were granted, there can be no legal flaw in the opinion of the Family Court directing temporary custody of the female child aged 4½ years to the father of the child for a period from 1.5.2013 to 16.5.2013.

Petition, devoid of merit, is rejected.
