This Criminal Petition coming on for orders this day, the Court made the following: -

### ORDER

Heard both sides. Accused Nos.3 to 5 in connection with the Crime No.167/2011 of Chikkajajur Police Station have moved this application under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. The petitioners herein are said to have joined with accused No.1 on 18.08.2011 to kidnap a girl by name Sudha. Accused No.1, who is the main accused is said to be in J.C. The role of the petitioners are that they were in a car used for commission of the offence. The offence having occurred on 18.08.2011 and the charge sheet being filed, the events probablise that the Investigation Officer is not interested in arresting the petitioners. So, the submission of the learned advocate for anticipatory bail is accepted.

2. In the result, the Criminal Petition is allowed. The petitioners to appear before the Investigation Officer within

- (i) The petitioners shall not interfere with the investigation or influence the witnesses:
- (ii) The petitioners shall appear before the Investigating Officer whenever directed for investigation;
- (iii) The petitioners shall mark the attendance at Chikkajajur Police Station between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. once in two weeks for one year.
- (iv) In the event of such an arrest and release, the petitioners shall move for regular bail within one month from the date of release on bail.
