PASSED THE FOLLOWING:

**CONCILIATION ORDER**

The learned counsel for the appellants/claimants  
and the learned counsel for respondent – Insurance  
Company are present.

2. After due deliberations, the parties have  
arrived at a settlement. The appellants/claimants have  
agreed to receive and respondent - Insurance Company  
has agreed to pay global compensation of Rs.6,50,000/-  
(Rupees Six Lakhs Fifty Thousand Only) in addition to  
what has been awarded by the Tribunal, towards full  
and final settlement of the claim. A joint memo is filed  
on behalf of the parties to this effect.

3. The respondent - Insurance Company has  
agreed to deposit the said amount before the Tribunal,  
within six weeks from the date of preparation of the  
award, failing which, the said amount shall carry

interest at 9% p.a. from the date of default, till the date of deposit.

4. The apportionment and disbursement of the enhanced amount shall be in terms of the award of the Tribunal.

5. Accordingly, Miscellaneous First Appeal stands disposed of in terms of the Joint Memo and the award of the Tribunal shall stand modified. Draw the award accordingly.
