This criminal petition is filed under Section 439 CrPC by the Advocate for the petitioner praying to enlarge the petitioner on bail in C.C. No.14070 of 2008 on the file of I Addl. CMM, Bangalore City for the offences punishable under Sections 143, 144, 147, 148, 120-B, 341, 302 read with 149 of IPC.

This Criminal Petition coming on for orders, this day, the court made the following:

**ORDER**

Heard.

2. The Petitioner is arrested for the offences punishable under Sections 143, 144, 147, 148, 120-B, 341, 302 read with 149 of IPC. According to the learned SPP, investigation is already over and the charge-sheet has also been filed and the case is committed for trial.

3. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner shall be enlarged on bail on his executing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees fifteen Thousand) with two sureties each for a likesum to the



satisfaction of the jurisdictional Court, subject to the following conditions.

- a. The petitioner shall report before the concerned jurisdictional Court where the case is pending, on every Monday of the first week of every month at 10.00 a.m. and thereafter, shall also make himself available before the respondent as and when required.
- b. Petitioner shall not leave the jurisdictional police limits without prior permission.
- c. Petitioner shall not tamper with the witnesses or in any manner interfere with or put obstacle to the investigation.
- d. Breach of any one of the above conditions will entitle the prosecution to move this Court for cancellation of the bail granted.
