After arguing the matter for some time, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that, the petitioners are permitted to make one more application/representation seeking similar relief from the respondent-authorities. In the event, if the petitioners file one more representation to the competent authority within two weeks from the receipt of the order, the same shall be considered by the competent authority within three months from the receipt of the such representation that may be filed by the petitioners. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of.
