THIS CRIMINAL PETITION COMING ON FOR ADMISSION THIS DAY, THE COURT MADE THE FOLLOWING:-

## **ORDER**

The petitioner is charge sheeted for the offences punishable under Sections 468, 471 and 420 of IPC r/w. Section 3(1)(ix) of SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

2. The allegation against the petitioner is, without producing the documentary proof he has obtained false caste certificate. The case was registered on 08.02.2005. Now, the petitioner has produced a report of the District Caste Verification Committee dated 18.05.2013 endorsing that on verification of the documents produced by the petitioner, it is confirmed that he belongs to 'Jenu Kuruba' (Scheduled Tribe) community. Before the District Caste Verification Committee could take its decision, this complaint is filed by the Tahsildhar. The complaint allegation is skeptical and the FIR registered on such baseless complaint is vitiated. As per

the documents at Annexure 'C', the Government had initiated disciplinary proceedings against the petitioner on the very same allegation of obtaining false caste certificate. Consequent upon the order passed by the District Caste Verification Committee, the disciplinary proceedings is dropped.

3. In the light of the above, allowing the criminal proceedings to continue is nothing but sheer abuse of the process of law and the entire proceedings is liable to be quashed.

## 4. The petition is allowed.

The crime No.44/2005 registered by the first respondent / Ulsoor Gate Police and the consequential criminal proceedings in C.C.No.12030/2012 on the file of the 6<sup>th</sup> Additional CMM, Bengalore is quashed.
