ORDER

Learned counsel for the petitioner has filed the memo for disposal on 23.09.2022 alongwith the Government Order dated 15.09.2022. Same is taken on record.

2. The memo reads as hereunder:-

"The petitioner had challenged the posting given to the 3rd Respondent of 4 posts. After issuance of notice the Govt. has now issued fresh order posting the petitioner as per order dated 15/9/2022. Pursuant to that order petitioner reported for duty. Copy of the order dated 15/9/2022 and reporting for duty and permitting the petitioner to discharge duties are produced herewith. In view of these developments the above petition does not survive for consideration.

Noticing the above facts the Writ Petition may kindly be disposed off, in the interest of justice and equity."

3. In light of the memo filed, this petition is ***disposed off***, as not calling for any further adjudication.
