

**ORDER**

This is a 439 petition in respect of Crime No.183/2008 registered by the Sakaleshpur Police on 14.09.2008 for offences punishable under Section 397, 120-B, 201 IPC.

Though initially the petitioner himself is a complainant later accused No.2 was arrested and in his voluntary statement he has revealed <sup>that, ✓</sup> the dacoity committed at the instance of the petitioner. During the course of investigation, the police have also secured the mobile phone of the petitioner who informed the other accused who committed the offence. The innocent traveler's valuable articles were looted by the accused. Prima face the record shows the involvement of the petitioner. It is dangerous to the society to enlarge the petitioner on bail and it is also stated that there is also a recovery.



3. I do not find any justification for grant of bail.  
Petition is dismissed.
