VIKRAMAJIT SEN, C.J. (Oral):

The main contention is that, prior to the passing of the order dated 31.07.2012, directing the petitioner to stop quarrying activity with immediate effect in the 'Patta' lands, owned by him in respect of which quarrying licence were granted, no opportunity of being heard had been offered to the petitioner. Accordingly, the principles of natural justice audi alteram partem, have been violated.

- 2. Having heard the learned counsel for the parties, the course that commends itself to us is that, the order dated 31.07.2012 shall be treated as a show-cause notice to the petitioner, who may file a response within two weeks from today. The petitioner shall appear before the Deputy Director, Departments of Mines and Geology, Chamarajanagar on 13th September 2012 for a personal hearing. A speaking order shall, thereafter be passed by the said Authority within fifteen days thereafter.
 - 3. The petition is allowed in these terms.
