CROSS OBJECTIONS FILED U/O 41 R 22 CPC AGAINST THE JUDGMENT DT.28.6.2000 PASSED IN CASE NO.WCAF.42/98 ON THE FILE OF W.C COMMISSIONER, GADAG ALLOWING THE CLAIM PETITION FOR COMPENSATION.

JUDGMENT

The substantial question of law involved in these appeals is as follows:

"Whether the tractor and trailer both should be insured in order to fasten the liability on the insurer?"

2. The Division Bench of this Court in the case of the ORIENTAL INSURANCE CO. LTD., Vs. D. LAXMAN AND OTHERS reported in ILR 2006 KAR 4355 has approved the ratio of the decision of the learned Single Judge of this Court in the case of NATIONAL INSURANCE COMPANY LTD., Vs. THIRAKAPPA RAMAPPA ITAGI AND ANOTHER (ILR 2001 KAR 3037) wherein at Paragraph 25, it is observed as under:

"The Division followed the view of the Full Bench reported in NATIONAL INSURANCE COMPANY LTD., Vs. hold that DUNDAMNA to tractor-trailer goods ĺ9 vehicle. Considering tariff separately available for the trailers under Clause 'A(3)', the Division Bench was of the view that both Trailer Tractor and independently considered as motor vehicle and should be individually inured. The



COYSI Insurance Tractor available to the automatically ba extended to the trailer and the trailer also should be separately insured within the o. Clause meaning available under Section 64(v) of the Insurance Act. That is how the word 'are' used as against the noun called as 'A trailer' tractor and 2 attached thereto. deliberately using the word 'ara' means that both the tractor and the trailer must have been insured."

- 3. In the instant case, the elleged deceased workmen was travelling in the trailer attached to a tractor. The tractor is not insured. The trailer is insured. The tractor and trailer put together constitute a goods vehicle. It is laid down in the above ratio that the insurer becomes liable only when both the tractor and the trailer are insured. In the instant case, the tractor is not insured. As such, the order is liable to be set aside.
 - 4. In the result, the appeals are allowed.
- 5. The amount in deposit is ordered to be refunded to the insurer.

- 6. In so far as the Cross Appeal is concerned, the compensation assessed by the Commissioner for Workmen's Compensation is sound and proper and does not call for interference.
- 7. The Cross Appeal No.115/80 in MFA No.9244/00 is dismissed.
