ORDER

The petitioner is arrested in Crime No.149/2009 registered by Malur Police on 2.6.2009 for an offence punishable under Section 20B of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

2. The police raided the premises on definite information on 2.6.2009 and found that the accused was selling 2.5Kgs. of ganja. The accused have been in judicial custody from June 2009. Considering the quantity of ganja seized and the gravity of the offence and further accused being the farmer and resident of the same village, I find that the petitioner can be enlarged on bail.

3. Accordingly, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is enlarged on bail, subject to the following conditions:

- a) The petitioner shall execute personal bond for Rs.25,000/- with one solvent surety for**



the likesum amount to the satisfaction of
the learned Magistrate.

- b) The petitioner shall not tamper with the
prosecution witnesses and the evidence.
