2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the
parties.

3. In this writ petition, the grievance of the
petitioner is with regard to non-consideration of his



representation dated 11.11.2024 (Annexures-R and S) by the respondent-authorities.

4. Sri. K. Krishna, learned counsel appearing for the respondent- Bangalore Development Authority (for short, BDA) submitted that representation dated 11.11.2024 is made by Kodigehalli Revenue Site Holders Welfare Committee (registered) and not by the petitioner. In that view of the matter, it is open for the petitioner to make one more representation to the respondent-BDA along with Annexure-R and S dated 11.11.2024 to enable the respondent-BDA to take decision in the matter in accordance with law. If such a representation is made by the petitioner within one week from the from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, the same shall be considered by the respondent-BDA within an outer limit of four months, thereafter, in the light of the observation made by the Division Bench of this Court vide order



dated 22.02.2024 passed in WA No.1783 of 2024 and connected appeals. Accordingly, the writ petition is ***disposed of.***
