THIS WRIT PETITION IS FILED UNDER ARTICLES 226 AND 227 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA PRAYING TO DIRECT THE RESPONDENTS TO GRANT MEDICAL CLAIM OF RS.64,605/- WITH INTEREST AT THE RATE OF 18% PER ANNUM FROM 25.05.2009 AS PER ANNEXURES G1 TO G15.

THIS PETITION COMING ON FOR PRELIMINARY HEARING IB 'B' GROUP THIS DAY, THE COURT MADE THE FOLLOWING:

ORDER

Petitioner is an employee of Hindustan Machine Tools Limited, Jalahalli, Bangalore – 560 013. He has put forth a claim that his son took treatment at Narayana Nethralaya, Nodal Hospital, on the reference made and the said claim has not been settled till date. The grievance of the petitioner is with regard to non-grant of medical claim of Rs.64,605/-, as per Annexures – G to G15.

2. Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is an employee and has raised a claim for reimbursement of the medical expenditure allegedly incurred in connection with the treatment got obtained to his son, in my opinion, there is need for the respondent to

consider the grievance in accordance with law and in case the petitioner is entitled for reimbursement, to reimburse the legitimate amount, within an outer limit of three months, as otherwise, the petitioner be informed of the reasons for the non-entitlement of the claim made.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
