- 6. The respondent No.3 has agreed to deposit the said amount before the Tribunal, within Six weeks from the date of preparation of the award, failing which, the said amount shall carry interest at the rate of 9% per annum from the date of default, till the date of deposit.
- 7. Parties are not entitled to any costs.

8. The terms of the joint memo is agreed to be full and final

settlement between the parties with their free will and consent.

9. The apportionment, release and fixed deposit, if any, would be in accordance with terms of the original award.

The appeal is settled and stands disposed off on the above terms.
