This Criminal Revision Petition is filed under Section 397(1) R/w Sec.401 of Cr.P.C. praying to set aside the order dated 02.11.2011 passed in Criminal Appeal No.42/2011 by the Principal Sessions Judge Bijapur, and confirm the order dated 30.11.2010 passed by the Asst. Commissioner, Bijapur in the interest of justice and equity.

This Criminal Revision Petition coming on for order this day, the Court made the following:

ORDER

Respondent though served has remained absent. This revision petition is filed by the State against the judgment passed in Criminal Appeal No.42/2011 by Sessions Court, Bijapur. By the impugned judgment and order the Sessions Court having found that the respondent herein did not have opportunity to defend his case before the Assistant Commissioner, set aside the order passed by the Assistant Commissioner regarding confiscation of sugar and remitted the matter to the Assistant Commissioner.

This Court does not find any error in the impugned judgment inasmuch as the Sessions Judge is justified in setting aside the order passed by the Assistant Commissioner inasmuch as the same was in violation of principles of natural justice. By affording opportunity of hearing to the respondent, the truth will come out. Therefore, no interference is called for. Petition fails and the same stands *dismissed*.
