Both these applications are filed u/s 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail by the accused Nos.2 to 7 in WLOR (Kvt) 1/2022 of Kavarathi Forest Range Office.

- 2. The Bail Application No. 2443 of 2022 has been filed by the accused Nos. 4 to 7 and the Bail Application No. 2497 of 2022 has been filed by the accused No. 2 and 3. The offences alleged against the petitioners are under Sections 9, 39(3)(a), 44, 48 (A), 51, 52 & 56 of the Wild Life Protection Act, 1972 and Sections 23, 120A, 120(B)(2), 378, 410, 413, 414 & 425 of Indian Penal Code.
  - 3. I have heard the learned counsel for the

petitioners and the learned Standing Counsel for the Lakshadweep Administration.

- 4. The prosecution case in short is that on 22.02.2022 at 7.40 hours, the Indian Coast Guard Ship apprehended a boat by name 'Blue Water' and from the above boat, a satellite phone kept in hidden place was recovered. On interrogation, the crews of the boat admitted that they were for a scheduled shipment of contraband of sea cucumber from Lakshadweep boat. At 13.30 hours, the boat by name Zulfiker approached the boat by name Blue Water for delivering contrabands and 30 live sea cucumbers were confiscated.
  - 5. Heard both sides and perused the case diary.
- 6. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are absolutely innocent and they have been falsely implicated in the present case. He further submitted that there are no materials to

connect the petitioners with the alleged crime and hence they are entitled to get bail. The learned Public Prosecutor opposed the bail application. He contended that the alleged incident occurred as a part of the intentional criminal acts of the petitioners and if the petitioners are released on bail at this stage, it would affect the course of investigation.

7. Perusal of the case diary would reveal that *prima facie* there are materials on record to connect the petitioners with the crime. However, the petitioners were remanded to judicial custody on 24.02.2022. In view of the nature of the crime and the stage of investigation, I do not find any reason to hold that the continued detention of the petitioners is required for any purpose. The investigation seems to have reached a fair stage. For all these reasons, the petitioners are entitled to be released on bail on conditions.

In the result, these applications are allowed on the following conditions:-

- (i) The petitioners shall be released on bail on executing a bond for Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One lakh only) each with two solvent sureties for the like sum each to the satisfaction of the jurisdictional Magistrate/Court. The petitioners in the Bail Application No. 2443 of 2022 shall offer sureties from the Lakshadweep Islands.
- (ii) The petitioners shall fully co-operate with the investigation.
- (iii) The petitioners in the Bail Application No. 2497 of 2022 shall appear before the investigating officer between 10.00 a.m and 11.00 a.m on every Saturday until further orders. The petitioners in the Bail Application No. 2443 of 2022 shall appear before the investigating officer as and when required by him.
  - (iv) The petitioners shall not commit any offence of

like nature while on bail.

(v) The petitioners shall not make any attempt to contact any of the prosecution witnesses, directly or through any other person, or any other way try to tamper with the evidence or influence any witnesses or other persons related to the investigation.
