J U D G M E N T

The above writ petition is filed with the following prayers:-

(I) issue a writ of mandamus or other appropriate writ, order or direction commanding the 5th Respondent to approve the appointment of the Petitioners and grant the attendant benefits forthwith;

(ii) issue a writ of mandamus or other appropriate writ, order or direction commanding the 1st respondent to consider and issue orders on Exhibit P7 revision petition which was filed by the petitioner after affording an opportunity to hear the petitioner;

(iii) Dispense with filing of the translation of vernacular documents;

(iv) pass such other order or direction which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper to grant in the circumstances of the case.

2. When this writ petition came up for consideration, the learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner will be satisfied, if a direction is issued to the first

respondent to consider Ext.P7, within a time frame.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Pleader.

4. After hearing both sides, I am of the considered opinion that, this writ petition itself can be disposed of, with a direction to the first respondent to consider Ext.P7 within a time frame. Therefore, this writ petition is disposed of with the following directions:

(1) The first respondent is directed to consider and pass orders in Ext.P7, after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and the sixth respondent, as expeditiously as possible, at any rate, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment;

(2) The petitioner will produce a certified copy of the judgment along with the copy of this writ petition before the first respondent for compliance.

With the above directions, this writ petition is disposed of.
