JUDGMENT

This writ petition is filed with following prayers:

- i. Issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, direction or order directing the respondents to cancel the ongoing tender proceedings and to invite a new tender by following all requisites mandated by law.
- ii. Issue of a Writ of Certiorari or any other appropriate writ, order or direction directing the Respondent 1 & 2 to quash the decision to finalise the tender bidding held on 13.08.2021.
- iii. Issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, direction or order, directing the 1st Respondent to consider Exhibit P3 as expeditiously as possible and pass appropriate orders thereon in the interest of justice.
- iv. To issue such other relief's as this Honourable Court may pleased, deem fit and proper in the circumstances of this case.

When this writ petition came up for consideration, the learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondents submitted that the tender proceedings are already over and the tender was confirmed in the name of one Krishnakumar. The learned Standing Counsel also submitted that his work order was cancelled and the same is the subject matter in W.P.(C).No.25081 of 2021. In the light of the above facts, the prayers in this writ petition are infructuous.

Therefore, this writ petition is dismissed as infructuous, granting liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court again, if there is any fresh cause of action.
