**JUDGMENT**

The writ petition is filed to direct the respondents 2 and 3 to afford adequate police protection to the life of the petitioner and her family members from any threat of the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent and his men.

2. When the writ petition came up for consideration on 25.08.2023, this Court directed the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent to afford adequate police protection to the life of the petitioner from the threat of the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent without interfering in any civil dispute between the parties.

3. Heard; the learned counsel for the petitioner, the learned Government Pleader and the learned counsel for the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent.

4. The learned counsel for the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent submitted that, Ext.P1 title deed has already been set



aside by the Court of Subordinate Judge, Thodupuzha in O.S.No.80/2023. Therefore, the petitioner has no legal right to reside in the property covered by Ext.P1.

5. On a consideration of the facts and materials on record, I am of the view that a quietus can be given to the writ petition, by permitting the petitioner to approach the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent, in case there is any threat to her life. If such complaint is filed, the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent shall act upon the complaint, without interfering in any civil dispute between the petitioner and the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent.

The writ petition is ordered accordingly.
